

Breakfast, lunch, and dinner are served weekdays, brunch is served on Saturday, and brunch and dinner are served on Sundays. You will be responsible for at least two meals on your own during each session. Meals are served across the courtyard at The Statesider.

Payments

Due to the demand for our Madison programs, payments must be made in full for the first session registered. (1) All payments are refundable until April 1, 2011, less a \$100 administrative fee. (2) An additional 3% service charge will be added to payments made by credit card. (3) All final payments are due in full by April 1, 2011. A \$50 late fee will be assessed for each 30 day period of delinquency. (4) While we guarantee you the style of accommodation you sign up for, please understand that each apartment is unique with regard to square footage and configuration.

Cancellations & Refunds

If you need to cancel for any reason, until April 1, 2011 you are guaranteed to receive your deposit or payment back less a \$100 adminstrative fee. After April 1, 2011, refunds will only be possible if travel insurance has been purchased, either through Senior Summer School or an outside provider. Senior Summer School offers comprehensive travel insurance, which includes program cancellation, airfare, baggage, and medical coverage. For a low additional cost, this insurance is available to all Senior Summer School participants. Information with further details, including rates and terms, will be sent upon registration.
