Nations forces and 375,000 tons of cargo and gear from the Port of Hungnam and Wonson Korea in December 1950 just ahead of advancing North Korean forces.

On March 12, 2011 the only surviving, fully operational Victory ship left in the world will honor refugees and veterans alike with a daylong tribute aboard the SS

Lane Victory in San Pedro. The SS Lane Victory played a critical role in what was to become one of the largest



evacuations in military history . On December 6, 1950, the Lane took 7,009 Korean refugees aboard and safely transported them south to

Pusan. Additionally, her sister ship the Meredith Victory evacuated 14,000 refu-



gees on Dec. 22, 1950 just ahead of advancing North Korean forces who had cut off the port of Hungnam trapping thousands of refugees and sol-

diers without food or supplies as advancing Communist forces executed many refugees and entire families suspected of aiding UN forces, burning towns and taking terrible reprisal against all those fleeing.

All in all, 200 ships successfully evacuated the ports of Hungnam and Wonson in a relatively short three weeks. Today, consid-

ered one of the most remarkable evacuations in history, the event will be
