CLEMMONS, NC – Some screen readers for the visually disabled can be limited in their voice qualities and features. Text to Speech programs like *TextAloud* from **NextUp.com**, however, can offer excellent assistive support to the visually disabled, as well as more flexibility on voice quality and choices. later listening, using separate and specific Premium Voices for each type of content. This way, he can instantly distinguish between e-mails, newspapers, and other website content as he listens to the files via CD as well as computer. "The ability to choose multiple voice engines can also break up the monotony of long articles," he adds, "and different voices for different articles can help to distinguish between work-related and personal documents. I'm able to convert directly to audio file without having to use expensive or multiple programs to get the same result."

Lee utilizes several of *TextAloud*'s useful features to streamline his work, like the shortcut keys that enable users to play, pause or export an article with the single press of a button. "The voices are exceptional," he adds, "and each voice can be personalized or tweaked enough to give the impression of a real person reading aloud."

"Ultimately, *TextAloud* has provided me with the freedom from having to sit in front of my PC for countless hours listening to my stuff," says Lee. "It's great to have the freedom to listen on the go!"
