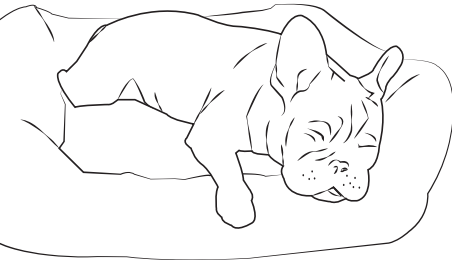




Sleeping behaviors and positions of small dogs

Snub did extensive research to craft the perfect bed for small pups. The combinations of our SnubFrame® + SnubPad® provide the support and comfort needed for the predominant sleeping styles and habits of dogs.



Belly sleeper. Most of the time when the dog is sleeping on his/her belly with all four paws out, s/he is simply dozing. SnubPads have overstuffed high-quality synthetic cotton to allow for maximum comfort for this sleeping position. Even after long-use and washing, the SnubPad stays fluffy and comfortable.



Back sleeper. This is a position where pups go into a deep sleep. Certainly one of the funniest of all sleep positions, s/he is on their back with all four legs in the air. There are two main reasons why this tends to be where the dog gets his/her most relaxed dream sleep. One, their stomach is exposed to the air to keep them cool. Two, by not being all curled up in a ball, his/her muscles aren't tense, and so s/he is able to be completely relaxed. The SnubFrame provides excellent support for the dogs head and allows for them to remain in this relaxed position for the length of their slumber.



Curled-in-ball sleeper. This position is a common napping position. Dogs tend to wake up fairly quickly from this position as their muscles are in their least relaxed state. The SnubBed provides maximum comfort and security in this position, but also allows easy access in and out of the bed with the dipped front.



Lying back to back with guardian or other pets. If you've ever seen or experienced this position, you may have thought it oddly human. When a dog sleeps back to back with its guardian or next to another dog, they are bonding; they feel safe protecting each other and it's a way of showing affection. While the SnubFrame can't provide emotional support, the back does mimic the protection desired by this position. The warmth of the faux fur and the height of the frame makes the dog feel safe.
