First Indian Hospital and Surgeons Awarded International Center of Excellence for Bariatric Surgery Designation

First Indian Designees Join SRC's Global Network of Providers Dedicated to High-Quality Patient Care

He is also credited with the creation and publication of new guidelines for <u>bariatric/metabolic surgery</u> that are specific to the Asian genotype.

Dr. Aparna Bhasker is the <u>youngest female bariatric surgeon</u> from Asia credited with heading an all women clinic in India and having performed the largest series of single incision bariatric procedures in Asia.

"Receiving this important distinction is a remarkable achievement and a testimony to the hard work and dedication of our bariatric team and hospital," said Dr. Lakdawala. "Achieving ICE designation strengthens our department's acceptability across the globe and the BOLD database will be instrumental in showcasing the good work being done in India and Asia in the field of bariatric and metabolic surgery."

To support center of excellence program compliance and quality improvement in patient care, SRC has developed BOLD, a longitudinal outcomes database. BOLD is now the world's largest repository of clinical patient data for the bariatric surgery specialty. As participants in the program, the designees will contribute valuable clinical data on various patient populations, interventions and care options which help to advance industry best practices.
