CLEMMONS, NC – Like many people around the world, **Jordan Star** enjoys reading and web surfing in his free time, but his legal blindness can make this difficult for the Long Island resident, even when he uses screen readers created especially for the blind. However, Jordan soon discovered a new solution in *TextAloud*, as the Text to Speech software by NextUp.com provided a handy and easy to use assistive alternative. "I found **TextAloud** to be a real help almost immediately, as it allowed me to convert e-text and eBooks to audio files very quickly and easily so that my active reading activities could continue," comments Jordan, who listens to his files on a multifunction Sony MP3/CD player. "This meant that I could now listen to books instead of trying to see to read them." Once the PC software became a mainstay for his regular reading, Jordan then discovered how to use

TextAloud to listen to his e-mails and websites, which further eased the tension of his visual disability, and saved his eyes from strain and fatigue.

The more Jordan utilized *TextAloud*, the more uses he seemed to find for it. "*TextAloud* is affordable, and far easier to use than *JAWS* or *ZoomText*, which are Text to Speech programs that are popular with blind people (and which are very expensive)," he adds. Jordan also proofreads his e-mails by listening with *TextAloud*, with the huge array of optional Premium Voices available for the program another pleasant surprise. "The different voices are definitely another discovery for me," he adds. However, it's really the program's flexibility that he enjoys even more, as files can be converted to a variety of popular audio file formats, and can be played on almost anything, from iPhones[®] and iPods[®], even to televisions. "It's great to be able to listen to the multitude of eBooks available out there to enrich one's life. The quality and clarity of the voices is excellent, and adds variety – they're not boring like too many other computer-generated voices in readers for the blind."


