



# You are invited to the All Town Celebration

on **Sunday April 17, 2011** at the **FLAGLER MUSEUM**

**Parade** - Residents are welcome to walk in the promenade of students, antique cars, fire trucks, local heroes, police motorcycles, elected officials and special organizations leaving from the Recreation Center at 6:00pm or stand on the sidewalk between Seaview Avenue and Pendleton Lane and watch the fun. The parade ends in front of the Poinciana Chapel at approximately 7:00pm.

**Celebration** - Starting at 6:00pm residents are invited to join the celebration on the front lawn of the Flagler Museum. Food offerings include your choice of beverage, sun chips and your choice of sandwich or pasta salad for \$5. The first 3,000 guests will receive free birthday cupcakes from Publix. Limited open seating is provided on a first come basis and residents are encouraged to bring blankets for open seating on the lawn. No alcohol, open coolers or private lawn chairs are permitted in the celebration area.

**Ceremony** - Residents will witness the Mayor, Town Council and other dignitaries as we recognize the centennial milestone together in this "All Town Celebration" which includes musical entertainment, a specially produced film of local personalities, an extraordinary sound and light show utilizing the latest computer-generated visual effects, graphics and night sky illumination. The ceremony begins at 8:00pm and concludes at 9:00pm.



**Cocoanut Row will be closed between Royal Palm Way and Royal Poinciana Way - between 5:00pm and 11:00pm. Home owners may cross police barricades with identification.**

**There is very limited public parking near the event site. Residents are encouraged to walk or ride their bikes to the celebration.**



- Major donors with a valet parking pass will be permitted to access the Flagler Museum through the police check point at Royal Poinciana Way and Cocoanut Row.
- Limited preferred parking is available with a general parking pass until 7:00pm at the Royal Poinciana Way and Cocoanut Row police checkpoint.

**Limited Group transportation is provided as follows:**

• **To and From the South:** Buses will pick up residents at Phipps Ocean Park & Old Bridge Park at 5:00pm, 5:15pm, 5:30pm, 6:00pm, 6:15pm, 6:30pm, & 7:00pm at both locations. Group transportation is limited to the first 275 people at each location. Busses will return to the same locations in rotation starting at 9:15pm.

• **To and From the North:** Molly's Trolleys will pick up residents along North Ocean Blvd at the following intersections in 20 minute intervals starting at 5:00pm – La Puerta Way, Orange Grove Road, Eden Ave, The Beach Club Parking Lot, Cherry Lane, Tangier Ave and Wells Road. Group transportation is limited to the first 125 people at each location. Residents are cautioned to wear reflective clothing, use flash lights and take care when waiting for the trolleys. Trolleys will return to the same locations in rotation starting at 9:15pm.
