3. Finally, please note that there is no CESC individual complaints procedure in place. Therefore, you are invited to adjust your communication accordingly. [The CESC has been removed in it's entirely from the Communication with the revised communication submitted under the OP ICCPR.](#)

We acknowledge receipt of your e-mail dated 24 September 2007.

We note that you have made adjustments to your petition, including by removing the USA as the offending State. The complaint, however, continues to make extensive reference to facts occurred in and alleged violations by the USA. In order for us to proceed with a *prima facie* examination of the complaint by Mr. Wilfred, we would need additional information as to the alleged violations by Canada. May we also suggest that you leave out all superfluous information that is not directly related to the alleged violations of the ICCPR by Canada.
