

Pennsylvania School of Dental Medicine Philadelphia, Pennsylvania Patient Record Transfer



Problem

The University of Pennsylvania School of Dental Medicine was in need of a new, space saving way to transfer confidential patient records to their respective students. Their current system of traditional lockers took up too much floor space and was not user friendly. They turned to Datum for assistance with their project.



Solution

The ThruStak™ was the ultimate solution. This system was built into the walls of the chart room, featured 545 openings with individual locking doors on the outside for student access, and an open back for easy file sorting by the chart room staff.

Each student had their own locker, custom built to house the oversized folders of their patients' records. The new ThruStak™ also featured doors that opened from top to bottom, as opposed to the left-to-right hinged doors of the old system, which made accessing the lockers much easier, and caused less wear and tear on the doors themselves. The larger slots on the bottom were for instructor use.
