

Lower Merion High School Ardmore, Pennsylvania Athletic Equipment Storage



Problem

During the construction of their new school, the athletic department of Lower Merion High School decided that they needed a more organized, more centralized area for storing their athletic team equipment. They needed an update from their wood racks, bulk shelving, and bins. Datum had the perfect solution for the situation.



Solution

Datum installed a MobileTrak3[®] System equipped with 4Post[™] Shelving in the small equipment room adjacent to the school's gymnasium. The MobileTrak3[®] was designed specifically to give Lower Merion the storage they needed in the space they allotted.

The 4Post[™] Shelving in the system allowed for the storage of hanging and folded uniforms, helmets, balls, and other sports equipment. The new system aids the athletic directors and coaches in keeping inventory up to date and keeping the equipment in good condition.


