Biographical Information

Sharon Kleyne is Founder and Chairman of Bio-Logic Aqua Technologies Biomedical Research, Inc., the first company to create a global business in water and hydrotherapy research for human health. Mrs. Kleyne conceived and built the company and is the driving force behind all its scientific breakthroughs and marketing strategies. She currently holds the positions of Chairman, Research Director, and head of marketing and administration.

The Oregon native brings to the company two decades experience in research, entrepreneurial innovation and health educator. Since her early twenties, she has pursued a personal commitment to water, hydrotherapy research, and global health, seeking ways to alleviate environmentally-caused dry eye and dry skin.

In 1978, while volunteering with the American Cancer Society, Sharon observed that some terminal cancer patients retained a healthy outlook while others did not. This motivated her to begin researching a book on health and aging. In the process, Mrs. Kleyne discovered that no matter where you live in the world, moisture plays a key role in health and youthful appearance. The air, she observed, contributes a significant and *virtually overlooked* percentage of the body's moisture, especially to skin and eyes. Globally, she learned, air with fresh, unpolluted moisture is becoming increasingly scarce, resulting in moisture starvation, skin and eye dehydration, and premature aging. Moisture starvation causes numerous common diseases and conditions.

In 1989, Sharon discovered a natural spring in Oregon's famous Rogue River Valley. Research revealed that its water possessed a rare natural purity, pH-balance, and mineral content that made it far more easily absorbed by skin and eyes than other waters. This water, which she named "Bio-Logic Aqua® Absolute Premium Standard® tissue-culture grade of water," was subsequently proven to generate tissue-cell growth and promote eye and skin health. Sharon's breakthrough research into this water led to the founding, with her husband Bill, of Bio-Logic Aqua Technologies, the first company to specialize in water and hydrotherapy research, and the bottling and marketing of water for pharmaceutical use. The company has developed numerous breakthrough skin and eye moisturizing products to benefit health worldwide, and projects global annual sales in excess of one-billion dollars.



Bio-Logic Aqua Technologies' initial consumer product is Nature's Tears® EyeMist®, a revolutionary eye moisturizer applied as an ultra-fine mist rather than as formulated drops. Described as "a new paradigm in eye care," the product is generating much excitement and has gained the endorsement of professional journals and physicians worldwide. Several leading Ophthalmologists, Dermatologists, and Biochemists believe in Nature's Tears EyeMist so strongly that they have become part of the company.

As an American, Sharon Kleyne is deeply committed to her community. She has served on the boards of many volunteer organizations, with emphasis on health (American Cancer Society) and children (American Field Service). In 1997, Mrs. Kleyne originated the successful Rogue Riviera Water Festival and Charity Auction to raise money to combat childhood melanoma. The festival is now the Save-a-Child's Life Foundation®. In 2002, Sharon was appointed by US Congressman Tom Delay as Honorary Co-Chairman of the Business Advisory Council. She is a member of the Ophthalmic Women Leaders organization, the New York Children's Vision Coalition, the Optical Women's Association, the Vision Council of America, and The Conference Board - Management Associate Member.

Over the past decade Mrs. Kleyne has traveled the country lecturing, and working with biochemists, physicians and corporate leaders. She has produced TV shows; TV, radio and print commercials; educational material on the Internet, in print, and on CD-ROM disks; research literature and abstracts, etc.

Sharon has no plans to slow down, sell the company, or sell its stock on the public stock market. Instead, she looks forward to continuing her research to discover more about water, hydrotherapy, environmental moisture, moisture absorption by the body, and pharmaceutical applications for Bio-Logic Aqua. She is gratified that her work is setting new standards and creating new options for the health-care and pharmaceutical industries. Her discoveries about water, hydrotherapy and "Moisture for Life™" are helping to save or improve lives globally, and contributing to the economy and health of her community, state and nation.
