This toad habitat is thought to be the remaining population living within this tributary feeding into the Santa Ana River of Orange County.

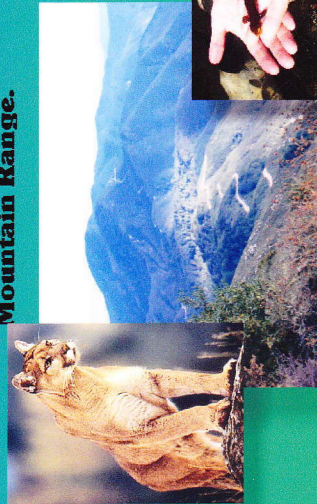

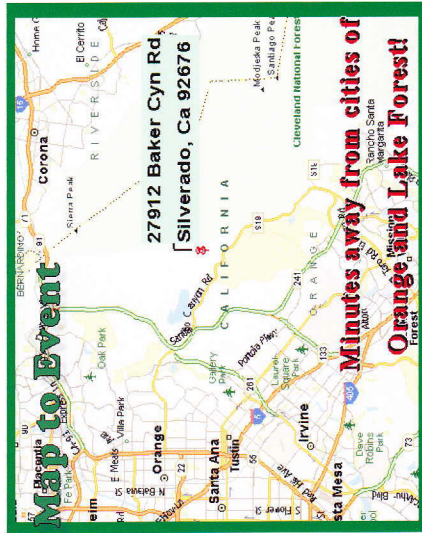

Directions: From north county: Take Chapman Ave. East from 55 fwy. (Santiago Cyn. Rd.) into foothills. Turn left on Silverado Cyn. Rd. and immediate left onto BlackStar Cyn. Rd. Turn right at Baker Cyn Rd to Santiago Event Center 27912 Baker Cyn. Rd.

From south county: Take El Toro Rd. (Santiago Cyn. Rd.) North, turn right onto Silverado Canyon Rd. and follow directions above via BlackStar and Baker Cyn Roads.
