



Speech and Language Explorers is a new program for children who:

have a known speech and language delay

would benefit from extra support in social communication skills

A specialized language-intensive program for children ages 4-6 with identified speech and language needs. Explorers is taught by a speech-language pathologist experienced in early childhood education. It employs a targeted, language-rich curriculum to support the foundation of speech and language skills and the development of early literacy, writing and math skills. Distinctive elements of the Explorers program include an activity-based learning model, special attention paid to the development of social language skills, and integral support from an occupational therapist.

Group size is limited to 4-6 children. Speech and Language Explorers may be an appropriate complement to a child's afternoon kindergarten program.

All children new to the Center will participate in a screening process to ensure an appropriate placement. Children admitted to the Speech and Language Explorers program will participate in an evaluation with a speech and language pathologist and occupational therapist. An individualized learning plan will be developed for each student.
