We will review the documents provided and let you know if your organization is eligible for Project ReStart. Only organizations that provide *all* the required information are eligible. Once qualified, your organization will be asked to sign a Project ReStart engagement letter and submit the required fees.

Small organization fee: \$495 plus IRS filing fee of \$100

(Small organizations must have gross receipts of \$25,000 or less through fiscal years beginning in 2009; \$50,000 or less in fiscal years beginning in 2010 or later).

Larger organization fee: \$995 plus the IRS filing fee of \$850.
