

MAYOR YOUNG TO HOST PRAYER VIGIL IN HONOR OF RUBIN DAVIS

MOUNT VERNON, NY – On Saturday, July 2, 2011 at 2:30 pm, Mount Vernon Mayor Clinton I. Young, Jr., Westchester County Board of Legislators Vice Chairman Lyndon Williams, the family of Mr. Rubin Davis, the Mount Vernon City Council, local clergy members and community leaders invite the public to participate in a prayer vigil in memory of Rubin Davis. Mr. Davis, an educated and outstanding member of the great City of Mount Vernon, was tragically gunned down last week in broad daylight while watching a basketball game at the Fourth Street Playground. These shootings have become an exception in Mount Vernon, and not the norm in our city. As residents of Mount Vernon, we cannot tolerate this senseless violence against our families and loved ones. I urge the community to work with the Police Department to bring his killer to justice. Let’s stand up for Rubin Davis! Let’s stand up for justice!” said Mount Vernon Mayor Clinton I. Young, Jr.
