- Get estimates from several self storage companies on storage unit. We recommend going online ad checking the facilities that you are considering for the positive reviews.
- Consider 24 hour access to your unit. Our facilities are open 7 days a week.
 Mon Fri. 9am 6pm, Sat. 9am 5pm, Sun. 1pm 5pm with access hours between 5am and 11pm 365 days a year. If this does not cover your needs we have 24 hour access available.
- Climate controlled storage units is a great option for a business. If your plan is to work out of the storage unit it is a must that you choose unit that is climate controlled. The temperatures in climate controlled units are kept between 55-80° which is crucial if you are planning of storing the following items:
 - Documents, photos and other paperwork.
 - Furniture
 - Computers & other office equipment
 - Pharmaceutical samples
 - Clothing
 - Archive documents
 - Any other items that should not be exposed to extreme temperatures
