Question Categories: Data Analysis

The pictograms are generally pretty straight forward - you just need to pay attention to what they are asking and what each picture represents. Sometimes they throw HALF pictures at you (one half a phone in this question would be 7,500 applications sold)

The SAT Ladder app sold $8 \times 15,000 = 120,000$ apps The Fun with Functions app sold $5 \times 15,000 = 75,000$ apps So, the SAT Ladder App sold 120,000 - 75,000 = 45,000 more copies.
