

Florida Litigation Partners with NetDirector:

Data Flow

You (the corporate legal department or law firm) enter a File (case) into Perfect Practice, CaseMax or other internal system as usual.

File/Defendant data is then automatically uploaded to NetDirector. This might include court, plaintiff, defendant, entity being served, address being served, important dates, etc.

↓ NetDirector transfer

NetDirector receives your data securely and passes it to Florida Litigation's database. Your fields and Florida Litigation's have been mapped in advance to match perfectly.

↓ NetDirector transfer

Florida Litigation receives the case from NetDirector.

YOUR FIRM



You control the switch and can choose to accept data from NetDirector or not. If you accept, the data is automatically entered in your database and the loop is closed.

↑ NetDirector transfer

NetDirector receives the update from Florida Litigation then passes it to you for an automatic update of your database.

↑ NetDirector transfer

Florida Litigation receives and validates the update to its database, then uploads to NetDirector.

1. Florida Litigation assigns the case to a process server who executes the job, then creates and signs the Return of Service.



2. Using a SmartPhone, the process server uploads the information, updating Florida Litigation in real time.
