□ Lack	of cleanliness, especially clothing

□ Char	nge in academic performance
<u>Discussions</u>	
	ments from friends about the homeless youth's situation or invitations to stay with them e student is not likely to share their own concerns at this age
<u>Parents</u>	
□ Expl	anations for absences or homework lapses don't make sense
