"Air" follows the life of a Latin youth who grew up in the South Bronx, the child of parents that were infected with the HIV virus. His story made worldwide headlines 15 years ago and inspired the book *The Air Down Here*, a story that documents the struggles that a child in his situation has to face on a daily basis.

We at the Círculo de la Hispanidad Long Island Hispanic Film Festival (CHLIHFF) are very pleased that the director/producer of "Air" has chosen to premiere this compelling documentary at the Inaugural event of the Long Island Hispanic Film Festival.
