A primary advantage of our program is the ability to access courses and student records from any computer with an internet connection, at any time.

Individuals in our online ILS program are given permissions-based logins and a dedicated database account number within our Learning Management System (LMS). All of the training records are retained indefinitely on a secure (128-bit SSL encrypted access), redundant server system. All course interactions by participants are recorded by the LMS, and learning records are automatically updated by the system. This information is available to participants and authorized administrators via learner grade books, certificates of completion, and manager consoles.
