This 263,000 sq. ft. facility employs automated processing lines utilizing multiple mechanical shredders, magnetic and eddy current separation technology, leading edge optical and electromagnetic based sortation and in-line sampling systems designed to maximize recovery values for downstream commodities, and a <u>new high volume CRT glass processing operation</u>.

Quick Facts

- Capacity: The Stockton facility is designed to process more than 25 million pounds of material per month.
- Location: It's easily accessible from West Coast's Interstate 5, Interstate 80 as well as California State Highways 4 and 99.
- History: The building is three years old, and was formerly operated by Kyoho Manufacturing California, which supplied pressed-metal parts to the now-defunct New United Motor Manufacturing Inc. (NUUMI) plant in Fremont.
- **Dock Operations:** The facilities have 12 operating dock doors and 24 additional "knock outs" for additional loading docks. We have the railroad spur running into the rear of the building.
