Managing student user accounts - log-in names, email accounts, etc. - continues to increase in complexity. Depending on the academic year and the teaching modules to be followed, a student needs access to a variety of applications, such as the file system and the electronic learning environment. If the school has a web portal, the student's parents also require access to specific information. At one time, it was feasible to set all of the required configurations manually, or with a script, once a year, those are days are long gone!

Uniform and Unequivocal User Management

The technology requirements within education are now complex. Details and access requirements change frequently within the year, and environments have become comprehensive because of numerous systems. Schools also have to cope with a large number of users, students and teachers, where many changes need to be applied, for example a student or teacher leaves the school, or takes another course.

Almost 50% of secondary schools, various teacher training colleges, regional training centers and universities with automated systems, use Tools4ever's User Management Resource Administrator (UMRA) to resolve these issues. UMRA streamlines the communication involved in user account changes. Because almost all school changes are maintained in the student information system, UMRA uses this system as the source for all adjustments.

Details Available Automatically

UMRA, by Tools4ever, ensures that the data from any student information system (for example Datatel or JPAMS) becomes available automatically and without any manual intervention, in the Active Directory, Exchange, eDirectory (Novell) or GroupWise file systems, as well as access systems, library systems, and Electronic Learning Environments (ELO).

UMRA communicates with virtually every system or application by using more than 130 preconfigured connectors. These links ensure total consistency and eliminates user account pollution in the network. The time interval for creating accounts is reduced significantly and accounts are always created flawlessly.

Any change in the Student Information System is detected by UMRA and the necessary actions are then undertaken.
