The text function also allowed delegates to comment, on the first day 43 messages came in in 13 minutes.

Mike Hayhurst reported back to IML saying "the mic activation facility is now on a par with traditional Sure SM58 hand-held radio mics. In a fast-moving training / conference environment for a major oil company, the functionality, clarity and speed of the mic on the handset was superb and alleviates all of the issues surrounding Q&A facilitation of delegate mics during such sessions".
