

Blazin' With Love 5K Run/Walk, sponsored by PowerNet Global, raises over \$20K

CINCINNATI, OH – October 26, 2011 – The first Annual Blazin' With Love 5K Run/Walk and Way North Sports Cornhole Tournament, presented by PowerNet Global, netted nearly \$21,000 for The Leukemia and Lymphoma Society (LLS), Tri-State Southern Ohio Chapter. More than 300 people braved the record-breaking 100-degree heat on September 3, including approximately 150 runners and 24 cornhole teams.

"Survival rates today are better than 80 percent, compared to only five percent just twenty years ago," notes Michelle Steed, executive director of the Leukemia and Lymphoma Society, Tri-State Southern Ohio Chapter. "With continuing research advancements, we can save even more lives, reduce treatment side effects, and hopefully, also find a cure one day."
