As you are aware, Korea is in need of delivering additional electrical power to some of its coastal islands. This need became more apparent during a recent power outage which left many residents without power for an extended period. Due to the cost of transmission of conventional energy from the mainland, as well as frequent cloudy conditions, Korea is solving this problem with wind power. Wind power will provide a measure of energy independence as well as lowered cost for these targeted areas. With this in mind, the government has set aside a budget of around \$1 billion for the purchase of several wind farms which in total will produce approximately 2,500 MW of power to solve this problem.


As a leader in Green technologies such as solar and biofuel, Greenb is honored to be in a position to present another cutting edge technological solution which we believe will help Korea as well as people world wide.

After reviewing products from many companies including Vestas, Siemens, and GE, I am very happy to inform you that the government of Korea has selected Infinity Energy and is waiting for your prototype for final decision on primary supplier of wind turbines for the above mentioned project. The reasons are a) the particular need in this region to be able to withstand very high speed wind speeds, b) the need for a greatly increased operational efficiency, and c) the need for a drastic reduction in maintenance cost in both time and money, relative to three propeller models, and d) a massive reduction of noise pollution. Infinity Energy has effectively solved all of these problems, and we believe the cost savings and increased power output for residents will be substantial as time goes on.

Upon successful certification and meeting the requirements of government for wind energy efficiency, we intend to order approximately 1,500MW to 2,500MW, with the above mentioned budget, for the purpose of supplying the southern coastal areas. Some wind farms will be on the islands, some will be along the mainland coast, and some will be further inland, which will provide the power necessary to fuel growth for residents and industry the foreseeable future. Again, we are happy to be a part of this process, and look forward to a long and prosperous relationship.
