

Leo Schachter Diamonds New York, New York Accounting Records & Reports



## **Problem**

When Leo Schachter Diamonds relocated, they found their previous system no longer efficient in their newly allotted filing area near their accounting department. Not only would the old system not fit, but they also needed to expand their filing capacity by at least 20%.





Datum utilizes design programs to create 3D color renderings for customers to see exactly what their unique storage system will look like in their facility, from size and scale to color and aesthetic appeal, before the system is purchased.

## Solution

Datum's solution was a MobileTrak5® System equipped with ThinStak® Shelving to house the company's accounting records and reports. This system consisted of 3 movable carriages and 2 stationary carriages to accommodate the growth the company needed. Due to the low ceilings, ThinStak® was chosen so an extra row of shelving could fit in the same vertical space as compared to traditional "L" and "T" shelving.

The client also wanted to keep the aesthetic appeal of their new front office area, so they opted to continue the carpeting from the surrounding area onto the decking of the MobileTrak5®, creating a seamless look between the floor and the decking. The new system not only fit perfectly in the allotted space, but it also resulted in additional storage capacity for the company's future record storage.
