



## Eye Safety for Hunters



### Safety Tips

Hunting safety relies on more than orange vests and keeping the “safety” on. Defog It anti-fog joins the National Shooting Sports Foundation and The International Hunter Education Association in reminding hunters to always wear eye protection.

Here are some other tips on shooting glasses:

- Choose wrap-around shooting glasses with shatter resistant lenses. Check for the ANSI rating to be sure they meet the guidelines for safety.
- Look for styles with UV protection, a real benefit for hunting in bright light.
- Choose color lenses to help increase contrast and improve clarity. Some frames come with changeable lenses for different conditions.
- Carry an anti-fog spray or cloth in your pocket or gear bag. When you see movement in the distance, fogged glasses are more than annoying – they can be dangerous.
