**Payments:**

A \$500 deposit is due for all programs purchased at the regular price. Full payment of program is due upon registration for any program purchased at a discounted rate. (1) All payments are refundable until March 30, 2012, less a \$100 administrative fee. (2) An additional 3% service charge will be added to payments made by credit card. (3) All final balances are due in full by April 2, 2012. A \$50 late fee will be assessed for each 30 day period of delinquency. (4) After March 30, 2012, full payment is due upon registration. **Cancellations & Refunds:**
