Founded in 1636, Providence was one of the first established cities in the United States. Situated at the mouth of the Providence River, at the head of Narragansett Bay, it is the capital and most populous city in the state. The 375-year-old city has been known at various times as "The Beehive of Industry," "The Renaissance City" and, today, "The Creative Capital," all of which reflect this scrappy city's journey through its own history. Its existence today is a modern rendition of an upscale, urban cultural playground, with a wealth of artistic, historical and educational sites. We'll explore the city's story, and its role in the foundation of a new nation. Providence is home to world-class (and world famous) educational institutions including Brown University, the Culinary Art Museum and the Rhode Island School of Design. We'll discover the best of what Providence has to offer.

The Wyndham Garden Providence offers a harbor-side setting with spectacular views. All rooms feature large windows and have been recently remodeled to offer maximum comfort. It is located a mile from downtown and within walking distance to Brown University and the Rhode Island School of Design.

**Payments:**
