Additional Information:

Kitchen supplies:

The kitchen has a microwave, refrigerator, and stove-top, but is not stocked with utensils, dishes, pots & pans. Walgreens is located two blocks from The Towers.

Toiletries:

The Towers supplies a travel sized bar of soap, plastic cups, and kleenex in each bathroom.

Housekeeping:

Light housekeeping is provided once in every 12-night session. Linens will be changed, trash removed, bathroom cleaned and the apartment will be dusted and vacuumed. Towel exchange will be available at the front desk twice weekly.

Things to bring:

We recommend bringing a reading lamp, an alarm clock, extra hangers, and a cell phone. Rooms are not equipped with telephones.

Transportation:

Fly into Dane County Regional-Truax Airport, which is about 6 miles from The Towers. Badger Cabs will be available for approximately \$15 including tip. No reservations are necessary. Badger Buses pick-up at Milwaukee or Chicago airports and drop off at Madison Memorial Union located 3 blocks from The Towers.

Meals:

The Statesider dining hall, across the courtyard, provides a variety of hot entrée options at each meal, a salad & fruit buffet and build your own deli sandwich station. You will be provided breakfast, lunch and dinner weekdays, and brunch and dinner on the weekends. There will be two or three meals you are responsible for on your own.

PLEASE NOTE: There will not be meal service provided in-between sessions. Meal service will resume with dinner on Sunday evening.

Payments:

A \$500 deposit is due for all programs purchased at the regular price. Full payment of program is due upon registration for any program purchased at a discounted rate. (1) All payments are refundable until March 30, 2012, less a \$100 administrative fee. (2) An additional 3% service charge will be added to payments made by credit card. (3) All final balances are due in full by April 2, 2012. A \$50 late fee will be assessed for each 30 day period of delinquency. (4) After April 2, 2012, full payment due upon registration. (5) While we guarantee you the style of accommodation you sign up for, please understand that each apartment is unique with regard to square footage, configuration and view.

Cancellations & Refunds:

In the case of cancellations, we will return any deposits or payments until March 30, 2012, less a \$100 administrative fee. After March 30, 2012, refunds will be available only to clients who have purchased travel insurance, either through Senior Summer School or an outside provider. Senior Summer School offers comprehensive travel insurance, which includes program cancellation, airfare, baggage, and medical coverage.
