CAPT. WILL LYLES, USA

Recipient of 3 Bronze Stars and 2 Purple Hearts is a graduate of Virginia Military Institute Will applied to the Army's Officer Candidate School. He was accepted and graduated. In 2003 he was commissioned as a 2nd Lieutenant Infantry Officer. In his second tour he was in one of the last surge brigades in Iraq. After his battalion suffered initial casualties they went the last 6 months without an attack. Will became a double amputee after stepping on an IED pressure plate. He hopes to complete a medical degree and give back in appreciation for the hard work done on his behalf.



SGT KENDRA COLEMAN, USA

A graduate of the Airborne School and stationed with the 173rd Airborne Brigade in Bamberg, Germany. Her platoon was attached to the 191 Cav Scouts. Her job was to train local police and keep the village of Charkh safe. After 18 months of no showers, sharing a tent with 18 smelly men and three women, and getting routinely attacked an IED blast took her left leg. Her fellow soldiers protected her and brought her to safety. Now Kendra is working on her Masters in prosthesis and hoping to marry the love of her life, start a family and settle in Texas.



SGT ALEX DEL RIO, USMC (RET.)

When Alex was 9 months old he had surgery to remove a tumor from his head. The doctors warned he would have trouble in sports. He proved them wrong. Inspired by many of his family, Alex joined the service. He became a Marine serving with the 1st Radio Battalion. On his 3rd deployment he was severely injured. Doctors were able to save his right arm and left hand, but he lost both legs. Alex has a wife and three children, and looks forward to finishing his degree.
