
Accommodations:

Additional Information:

Kitchen supplies:

The kitchen has a microwave, refrigerator, and stovetop, but is not stocked with utensils, dishes, pots & pans.

Toiletries:

There will be a travel sized bar of soap, plastic cups, and kleenex in each bathroom.

Housekeeping:

Light housekeeping is provided once throughout the session. Linens will be changed, trash removed, bathroom cleaned and the apartment will be dusted and vacuumed. Towel exchange will be available at the front desk twice weekly.

Things to bring:

We recommend bringing a reading lamp, an alarm clock, extra hangers, and a cell phone. Rooms are not equipped with telephones.

Payments:

A \$500 deposit is due for all programs purchased at the regular price. Full payment of program is due upon registration for any program purchased at a discounted rate. (1) All payments are refundable until March 30, 2012, less a \$100 administrative fee. (2) An additional 3% service charge will be added to payments made by credit card. (3) All final balances are due in full by April 2, 2012. A \$50 late fee will be assessed for each 30 day period of delinquency. (4) After April 2, 2012, full payment due upon registration. (5) While we guarantee you the style of accommodation you sign up for, please understand that each apartment is unique with regard to square footage, configuration and view.

<u>Meals</u>:

Meals are served at The Pavilion Dining Hall, which is about a 5 minute walk from the apartment building. You will be provided with a meal card and a cash balance that you monitor. All items are a la carte and you can dine at any of the wonderful options offered from the award winning food service operations. La Gran Terraza offers exquisite food in a luxurious restaurant setting overlooking Mission Bay. O'Toole's lounge is a casual restaurant setting. The meal card is set up for you to eat breakfast, lunch and dinner weekdays, and brunch and dinner on the weekends. There will be two or three meals that you are responsible for on your own.

Cancellations & Refunds:
