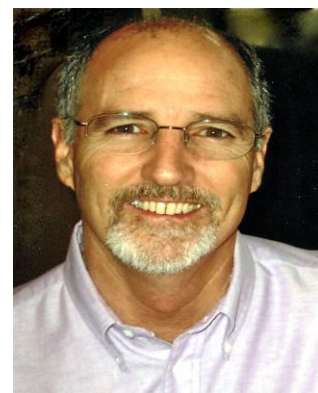


Fr. Richard Rohr Presents: "Breathing Under Water" "
