Singer/hospitality and music entrepreneur, Ellen Kaye (Moscow 57), will perform at the 11th Annual UN Women Luncheon on March 2, 2012 at The United Nations. UN Women is the United Nations Entity for Gender Equality and the Empowerment of Women. Cheryl Benton, President of the New York Chapter of the US National Committee for UN Women and founder The Three Tomatoes, invited Kaye after seeing one of her recent performances at The Metropolitan Room in New York. Special guests include Jeni Klugman, Director of Gender and Development at The World Bank and keynote speaker, Ambassador Anwarul Chowdhury.

Kaye is known for her gutsy, sensuous hybrid of blues, rock and folk. Kaye is the co-founder of entertainment and food consortium, Moscow 57, and the daughter of famed restaurateurs Faith Stewart Gordon and the late Sidney Kaye of the Russian Tea Room. She is a committed women's advocate who regularly earmarks earnings from her performances for advocacy groups such as The New York Women's Foundation, a cross-cultural alliance of women catalyzing partnerships and leveraging human and financial capital to achieve sustained economic security and justice for women and girls.

"An unceasing effort for the empowerment of women world-wide is a subject and a goal close to my heart," says Kaye. "I couldn't be more thrilled than I am for this opportunity to sing this ground breaking song at the UN Women's "Peace & Equality" event."
