Anthem College Online Hosting Criminal Justice Career Webinar March 1

Phoenix, AZ, February 28, 2012 — Anthem College Online will host a career webinar for Criminal Justice students on March 1, 2012.

Director of the Arizona Department of Juvenile Corrections (ADJC) Charles Flanagan will be on hand to share his expertise about the juvenile correction system. Students will learn about opportunities in the juvenile corrections field, the differences between juvenile and adult corrections, and the rehabilitative focus of this area of criminal justice.
