Winrow was able to take advantage of Bryman's flexible class scheduling and earn her degree while keeping her job. Since her promotion, she has hired ten Bryman graduates, all of whom also completed their Externships with her practice. Now on the other side of the employment market, she "would rather hire [Bryman] externs than anyone else. If they go through the whole program, I know they've made it through the hard stuff and that are going to be committed [to the job]."
