



South Middleton Township Boiling Springs, Pennsylvania Archival Storage



Problem

The South Middleton Township municipal building was renovating their current building to convert a garage with sloping floors in a storage area. Since their current form of bulk rack storage wasn't giving them what they needed for their files and paperwork, they decided that some sort of high density shelving to accommodate their current needs and future growth was needed.







Datum utilizes design programs to create 3D color renderings for customers to see exactly what their unique storage system will look like in their facility, from size and scale to color and aesthetic appeal, before the system is purchased.

Solution

The solution was a MobileTrak5® System equipped with legal sized 4Post™ Shelving and rolled plan storage.

Because of the drastically sloping floor used for drainage in the garage area, a special raised platform was created for a level surface and an ADA compliant ramp was added for a smooth transition into the system. The ramp made the system easily accessible with rolling carts, ladders, and wheelchairs.

The new system, standing over 10 feet tall, gave the municipal building room for their current files, and plenty of space for future growth.
