O. What is Distance Education?

Q. Is tuition assistance available? Yes. Military personnel, veterans and family members of active duty or veteran service members are eligible for tuition assistance through various military programs. Ashworth's Military Advisors are experienced in assisting service members and military spouses get the most from their education benefits.

Military personnel can get tuition assistance through these programs:

- Post 9/11 GI Bill and Montgomery GI Bill - Offers financial aid when you are working towards a college degree.
- **DANTE's** (Defense Activity for Non-Traditional Education Support) - Provides assistance when studying for a high school diploma, all career diplomas or a college degree.
- GoArmyEd Ashworth is a Letter of Intent (LOI) school in the GoArmyEd system, allowing Army students to use upfront Tuition Assistance (TA).
- Navy, Air Force, Marine Tuition Assistance - Provides aid toward career certificates and diplomas as well as for college degrees.

Military Spouses can receive up to \$4,000 in education benefits through Career Advancement Accounts (MyCAA).

O. Who teaches my courses? Ashworth courses are taught by seasoned educators who are also working professional in the fields they teach. You'll benefit from their professional experience and gain insight into what it's like to work in your chosen career.

O. Can I transfer credits to Ashworth?

Yes. With Ashworth's generous transfer policy, there are several ways you could receive up to 75% credit towards your degree program. Taking advantage of one or more can accelerate your graduation and save you money. Our Military Advisors can help you with details.

- We accept academic credits from a previous college or university. Our Registrar's office can help you determine how many of your credits will transfer.
- We give credit for previous academic, military, work and life experience.
- Many Ashworth programs can be transferred into a higher degree program.

Q. Can I pause my coursework if I am relocated or deployed?
