Tobacco smoke contains a deadly mix of more than


7,000 CHEMICALS

hundreds that are toxic and 69 that cause cancer.



HYDRAZINE

is found in rocket fuel. It's also found in cigarettes.



FORMALDEHYDE

is found in embalming fluid that's used to preserve the dead. Formaldehyde is also found in cigarette smoke.




ACETONE

removes nail polish. It is also found in cigarette smoke.


50,000 DEATHS

More than 46,000 non-smoking Americans die of heart disease each year, and 3,000 of lung cancer, primarily due to exposure to secondhand smoke.



RADIOACTIVE POLONIUM-210

is found in cigarette smoke. Polonium-210 contributes to cancer.



TOLUENE

is found in gasoline. It's also found in cigarette smoke.



BATTERIES CONTAIN CADMIUM.

So do cigarettes.



CARBON MONOXIDE

is a toxic gas, which can cause death, found in tobacco smoke.

HYDROGEN CYANIDE

exposure causes cardiovascular and respiratory illness. There's hydrogen cyanide in rat poison. There's also hydrogen cyanide in tobacco smoke.
