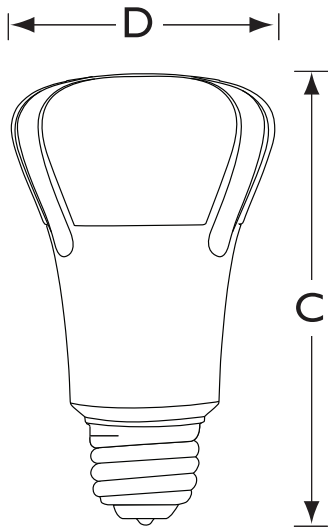

## Dimensional drawing



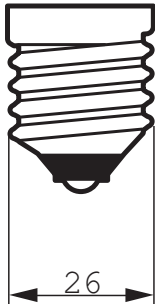
