Maine Resort Basks in the Sun

The Cliff House Resort & Spa Installs One of Maine's Largest Solar Thermal Projects

- One of the largest solar thermal projects in Maine The Cliff House Resort & Spa has installed 2,100 tubes on 70 collectors to harness the sun's energy to provide heating and hot water in its Spa building.
- The energy created from the solar thermal system is equivalent to that required for generating hot water for 35 households for a year.
- In the Spa building with its 32 guest rooms and 10 treatment rooms – 25-30% of heat and hot water will be generated by the sun.
- The Cliff House Resort & Spa will save about 11,000 gallons of propane each year by using the solar thermal system - reducing its use of fossil fuels by about 30%.

- 140,000 lbs of green house gas emissions will be kept out of the air each year this is equivalent to CO₂ emissions generated from the electricity used by 8 family homes in a year.
- A grant from the U.S. Department of Agriculture and federal tax credits helped offset project costs and reduce simple payback to less than six years.
