

- Infertility affects 7.8 million people in the US.
- Approximately one-third of infertility is attributed to the female partner, one-third to the male partner, and one-third is caused by a combination of both partners, or is unexplained.
- Couples aged 29-33 only as a 20-25% chance of conceiving in any given month.
- Only 44% of women with infertility have sought medical assistance. Of those, approximately 65% have given birth.
- Fewer than 3% of infertility cases require advanced treatment like *in vitro* fertilization.
- Some states have passed laws requiring that insurance policies cover some level of infertility treatment.
