If an over or under pour occurs, the software requires the proper adjustments to be made before the batch can be



moved to production. The information is then fed back to the inventory system adjusting the container of raw material by the exact weight as taken directly from the scale. No human error, no time delay in entry. 100% accurate information fed into the system translates into the elimination of rework, accurate inventory records and total traceability.
