PUBLIC SAFETY PLANS FOR ACCESS AT AND ADJACENT TO THE GOLDEN GATE BRIDGE ROADWAY, SIDEWALKS & PARKING Sunday, May 27, 2012, the 75th Anniversary

<u>San Francisco, CA:</u> Golden Gate Bridge, Highway and Transportation District (GGBHTD) and the California Highway Patrol (CHP) are responsible for the coordinated public safety plans at the Golden Gate Bridge and associated sidewalks and parking areas for the Memorial Holiday weekend and specifically Sunday, May 27, the 75th anniversary of the famed icon.

To make the Memorial weekend and May 27 safe and memorable for all, the GGBHTD and CHP are also coordinating with the U.S. Park Police, Presidio Trust, and Golden Gate National Recreation Area rangers who have jurisdiction at the Presidio, Crissy Field, and Fort Point, the San Francisco Police Department who have jurisdiction at Marina Green, and the U.S. Coast Guard who have jurisdiction on the Bay.

THE BASICS FOR SUNDAY, MAY 27, 2012

- Sunday, May 27, Golden Gate Festival, from Fort Point to Pier 39 is expected to draw tens of thousands of people.
- Please do not drive into or within San Francisco on May 27, as the City is anticipating severe traffic congestion and potential gridlock. For better,
- Plan now to take public transit, walk or bike to your destination, and plot your route beforehand.
- All parking in the event vicinity will be CLOSED on May 27.
- Golden Gate Festival starts at 11 am
- Fireworks start at approx. 9:30 pm along the waterfront from Fort Point to Marina Green, where visibility is optimum.
- Fireworks ARE NOT VISIBLE from EAST of Marina Green including the area from Fisherman's Wharf to The Embarcadero.
- Before, during, and after the fireworks, the public should anticipate severe traffic congestion with long delays.

- Presidio access from 9 am to 10 pm: Non-resident vehicles WILL NOT be allowed to enter at any of the Presidio gates. Presidio residents with passes may enter at the 14th and 25th Avenue gates only.

Sunday, May 27: OPEN at sunrise, CLOSURE IN progress 5 pm to 6 pm, OPEN to 6 pm, CLOSED 6 pm to

10:15 pm, OPEN 10:15 pm to 1 am for bikes only (times approximate)

Alexander Avenue at GGB north end to/from Sausalito

Sunday, May 27: OPEN to 6 pm, CLOSED 6 pm to MIDNIGHT to vehicles and remains OPEN for foot traffic and bicycles and REOPENS to vehicles once bikes and foot traffic clear at about MIDNIGHT (times approximate)

Presidio Access (at south end of GGB under Jurisdiction of The Presidio Trust)

9 am to 10 pm: The Presidio gates, except Marina Gate, will be **open only** to pedestrians, bicyclists, transit, taxis and shuttles. All vehicular access into The Presidio will be by pre-issued access pass only. Presidio residents with passes may enter through the 14th and 25th Avenue gates only. Taxis are welcome (except Marina Gate) and can drop off at the Main Post on Taylor Street between Lincoln Blvd. and Sheridan Ave. The PresidiGo shuttle will also provide bus service to Crissy Field.

Friday, May 25: Regular schedules and Saturday, May 26: Holiday schedules Sunday, May 27: (1) regular Holiday schedules PLUS added service on Routes 70 and 80 to/from San Francisco; (2) added bus shuttles connecting specific Highway 101 Park & Ride Lots in Sonoma County and Marin County to/from Larkspur Ferry Terminal where added ferry service connects to San Francisco where riders then ride MUNI to access the <u>Golden Gate Festival</u>. Return service is provided as well.
