QUALIFICATIONS, TERMS, CONDITIONS, INSTRUCTIONS, APPLICATION AND LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION

QUALIFICATIONS

All applicants for a Wites & Kapetan ("WKPA") DREAM Scholarship must:

- 1. have graduated from high school or have earned a GED certificate;
- 2. have been brought to the U.S. before they were sixteen;
- 3. have lived in the U.S. for at least the five continuous years;
- 4. demonstrate participation in community service;
- 5. be (or plan to be) enrolled as a full time student at any accredited college, university, technical or vocational school in the United States in the fall of 2012;
- 6. be of South or Central American (including Mexico) Heritage. To satisfy this requirement, the applicant must provide proof of birth in such country, or proof that at least one of the applicant's parents were born in such country; and
- 7. timely and fully complete an application, including the submission of all Supporting Documents.



TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The WKPA DREAM Scholarship will include the following Scholarship Awards:

First Prize	\$2,500
Second Prize	\$1,500
Third Prize	\$1,000

- 2. Scholarship Winners must submit requests for the Scholarship Funds to WKPA for Approved Purposes by November 1, 2012.
- 3. Approved Purposes include only tuition, fees, books, and lab fees at accredited colleges, universities, technical and/or vocational schools in the United States of America.
- 4. Submissions for Scholarship Funds may include only invoices and bills for Approved Purposes. WKPA will pay such invoices and bills, up to the amount of the Scholarship Award, directly to the applicable school or book store. Scholarship Awards will not be given directly to students. WKPA reserves the right to verify the validity of all Submissions.
- 5. Submissions not received by WKPA by 5:00 p.m. on September 14, 2012 will be forfeited. Any unclaimed Scholarship Awards, or portions thereof, will remain the property of Wites & Kapetan.
- 6. Scholarship Awards are not transferable, and may not be redeemed for cash.
- 7. Scholarship Winners must respond to notification of their Scholarship Award within 30 days of the date such notification is mailed or emailed by WKPA. The failure to timely respond will result in the forfeiture of the Scholarship Award.
- 8. Scholarship Winners agree that WKPA may use their name, photograph, and essays in press releases, advertisements and at <u>www.wklawyers.com</u> for the purpose of announcing and



congratulating the Scholarship Winners and publicizing the WKPA DREAM Scholarship.

- b. An official copy of your transcript from any college, university, technical and/or vocation school that you have attended.
- c. Proof that you or at least one of your parents was born in Brazil or another country in South or Central America, including Mexico. This may include a birth certificate, passport, and/or death certificate.
- d. An Essay which addresses the following topic:

Why I Want to be a Citizen of the United States of America.



Your essay must at least 500 words, double spaced, and typed.

Optional Materials: You may also submit up to 2 letters of recommendation (which must be from a present or former teacher or employer), as well as proof of your SAT and/or ACT Score.

3. **Submit Your Application**. Applications, including all Supporting Documents, must be submitted in a single envelope and must be addressed as follows:
