A Mr. Rooter plumbing service technician died and his brother suffered major injuries when their truck hit a pole Sunday morning on State Route 168 in North Beaver Borough, Pennsylvania.

Sean Christopher O'Hara, 22, of Beaver Falls, the passenger, died when he was ejected from the 1994 Ford Ranger just before 10:30 a.m. O'Hara worked for Mr. Rooter Plumbing, according to Bob Beall, president.

Bob Beall, president of Mr. Rooter Plumbing Pittsburgh and Youngstown says, "My wife and I have fostered 15 children and adopted three. Our hearts are breaking for Landon who will grow up without his Daddy." Beall, immediately upon hearing of the Mr. Rooter Plumbing service technician's tragic death, established The Landon O'Hara Fund for the toddler. The bank account was opened in the toddler's name at First National Bank, 20100 Route 19, Cranberry Township, PA 16066. Beall is using the power of IndieGoGo.com for donations and the goal has been set for \$50,000 in 120 days.
