In-depth knowledge of plant maintenance philosophies and design, operation and maintenance of equipment and systems within the terminal. Knowledge of FERC, USCG, DOT and OSHA regulations.

QUALIFICATIONS (EDUCATION, EXPERIENCE AND SKILLS):

1. Education and Certifications: A bachelor's degree in Mechanical Engineering is required and Professional Engineering License in good standing with at least one state is preferred

2. Experience: Minimum of 10 years experience as a Mechanical Engineer with a process plant background within the LNG industry. Static equipment experience is a must

3. Skills:

- a. Must be articulate and have effective organizational skills.
- b. A high level of safety awareness and knowledge of applicable LNG regulations is required.
- c. Excellent communication skills, both written and verbal.
- d. Computer literate with typical office packages simulation applications and basic computer literacy
- e. Excellent knowledge of the design, operation and maintenance of equipment and systems within the facility is required.
