NEW BOOK "THE PONY TRAP" EXPLORES NCAA PUNISHMENTS FROM AN INSIDER PERSPECTIVE

Author and former "Death Penalty" era SMU football player David Blewett offers his account of the 1987 team in the new book "The Pony Trap," available now.

Dallas, TX (July 24, 2012) – The most severe NCAA penalty ever levied, the 1987 Death Penalty on Southern Methodist University's football program, has been talked about and debated for decades.



Now, a new book <u>The Pony Trap: Escaping the 1987 SMU</u> <u>Football Death Penalty</u> examines the scandal from a player's perspective. A must read for anyone following the Penn State scandal, *The Pony Trap* offers insights into how NCAA penalties affect the innocent as well as the guilty parties.

David Blewett, author of *The Pony Trap*, was a third-year defensive end at SMU when the NCAA sanction hit the team. Though most players did not break any rules, the NCAA

punishment affected all of their football careers in different ways. While describing his motivations to discover how and why SMU was penalized, Blewett also describes the real reasons the NCAA chose to target SMU.

"When my daughter asked me if I did anything wrong at SMU, I knew it would never be over until I could tell her exactly what happened," said Blewett. 25 years after the Death Penalty destroyed SMU's football program, Blewett has a chance to tell his side of the story.

"Not one guilty person was penalized in any way under the Death Penalty," Blewett writes in *The Pony Trap*, "while us seventy-one innocent players were collectively grouped together, branded with a scarlet letter 'C' for cheating, and penalized for things done by individuals long gone. It wasn't right."
