### what

In conjunction with the DEA's National Drug Take Back Day on September 29, the goal is to give away 10,000 lockboxes- 100 in each of 100 communities.

where

The lockboxes will be given away in the communities of the sponsor's choice.

### how

\$500- name included on the card in the lock box as well as the flyers distributed to every person dropping off their meds.

\$1000- same as above with name or logo twice the size.

\$2500, \$5000 or \$7500- name or logo sized proportionally to the donation amount on the card, on the banner prominently displayed at the drop off site, and on the flyers distributed to every person dropping off their meds.

#### **Executive Summary**

In an effort to keep Rx drugs out of the wrong hands, the DEA sponsored a nationwide Drug Take Back Day in April, 2012 where people were able to drop off their unused/unwanted medications.

- 4,268 anti drug organizations and community groups participated in 5,659 take back events.
- 552,161 lbs (276 tons) of medications were collected and removed from medicine cabinets across the country.

The program was so successful that the DEA is sponsoring the event again on Sept 29, 2012. Drug Free America Foundation is taking this incredible event one step further by working with the participating organizations and coordinating a Medication Lockbox Giveaway in conjunction with the Take Back Events. Not only will medications be removed from medicine cabinets nationwide, but the remaining medicines in the homes will be secured. A powerful "1-2 punch".

#### Statement of Need

- Teens abuse Rx drugs more than cocaine, crack, heroin, and meth- COMBINED!
- 71,000 kids per yr end up in the ER due to unintentional overdose- 92% of them happen at home!
- The vast majority of teens abusing prescription drugs are getting them from the medicine cabinets of friends, family, and acquaintances.
- "Parents can have an immediate impact... by cutting off the access to Rx drugs in the home" -Office of National Drug Control Policy Report

### **Campaign Description**

Drug Free America Foundation, Inc. (DFAF), a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization, is seeking tax deductible donations to be used to purchase the lockboxes. DFAF will then arrange for them to be sent to the participating organization in the donor's area to be distributed to the public.

Those dropping off unwanted meds will receive a free lockbox along with a note enclosed letting them know who the donor was. Ex- "Please accept this lockbox as a gift from St. Elizabeth Hospital as a thank you for responsibly securing your medications." MedSafe, Inc. has agreed to support the campaign by discounting their MedSafe digital lockboxes by 25% to \$75 each including shipping, coordinating the distribution of the lockboxes, and funding the
